



QuantTB eCourse

What is the QuantTB eCourse and who should take it?

The QuantTB eLearning course is a self-paced course tailored to health professionals working in quantification; national TB program managers; pharmacists; implementing partners; international and local non-governmental organizations; and anyone using QuantTB as a forecasting, supply planning, and early warning system. This eCourse was developed through the US Agency for International Development-funded Systems for Improved Access to Pharmaceuticals and Services (SIAPS) Program, implemented by Management Sciences for Health, and is hosted on LeaderNet.

Why is this course needed and what does it cover?

The information contained in this eCourse is currently taught in person via a three-day workshop conducted by SIAPS. While the in-person workshops are highly effective, the recent progress in information and communication technologies provides a great opportunity for innovative ways to expand the number of procurement and quantification professionals who can easily access this information beyond the reach of one implementing partner.

The course includes two modules with interactive video demonstrations and knowledge checks. The first module is a refresher and provides relevant background information on general quantification. The second focuses on the use of the QuantTB tool. The full course takes approximately five hours to complete.
