

Why Pharmaceutical Systems Strengthening?



Investing in health systems strengthening creates an enabling environment to promote sustained equitable access to essential, high quality health services and medicines.

Through this global call we hope to highlight and make widely available some of the most successful strategies and actions that have been used to improve access to and use of pharmaceutical products and services around the world.

What is a pharmaceutical system?



A pharmaceutical system is a subunit of a health system which aims to achieve access to and rational use of medicines and ultimately improve health outcomes.

Why a Global Call?

To gather additional evidence in strengthening and sustaining responsive and resilient pharmaceutical systems

Case studies will demonstrate sustained improvements in pharmaceutical systems in low- and middle-income countries.

- Includes HSS interventions with a pharmaceutical component
- Focus can be on one or more components in systems strengthening
 - I.e. *Service delivery; health workforce; information; medical products; financing; leadership/governance, etc.*

Accepted case studies will be published online and in print.

Who can submit? What kind of submissions?


Submissions are open to all

- National governments, donors, USAID missions, local partners, and implementing partners, etc.

Current and past projects

Demonstrate **how** strategies and actions have improved access to and appropriate use of pharmaceutical products and services for better health outcomes.

Submission Criteria



1

A description of strategies and actions strengthening the health system to improve access to and use of medicines and health services.

2

Evidence demonstrating sustained improvements in health systems performance and/or health outcomes resulting from the intervention.

3

Actionable lessons and recommendations gained from implementation experiences.

Submission Guidelines

Submissions should not exceed 2,000 words.

The body of the case study should include the following:

- *Background*: Context and problem statement
- *Implementation*: Technical approach, strategies and actions
- *Results and lessons learned*: Evidence generated from program activities
- *Conclusion*: Brief discussion and practical, actionable recommendations

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
